What is SEE-N-READ™?

SEE-N-READ™ reading tools help readers *see*, *focus*, and *remember* what they read.

- **SEE:** SEE-N-READ™ helps readers to concentrate on and track text with their eyes and to smoothly move between the words that come before or after text being read. This helps readers to increase their fluency (*the ability to read text accurately and quickly*) and comprehension (*understanding of meaning*).
 - **FOCUS:** Effective readers read groups of words (chunks) at one time. SEE-N-READ'S™ clear reading window helps readers to focus on manageable "chunks" of information in each line of text. The non-glare tinted transparent finish around the clear window allows readers to move smoothly to the next line without stopping their eyes.
 - **Remember:** SEE-N-READ™ helps readers control their eye movements across the text on a page. This helps readers concentrate on content instead of on the location of the words, thus improving reading comprehension.
- **Who may need SEE-N-READ™?**
 - Readers who skip words or lines while reading or have trouble focusing their eyes.
 - Readers identified as having reading performance or skill deficiencies
 - Readers who read large amounts of detailed material requiring concentration
 - Teachers who need to highlight specific items on overhead projectors without covering all of the remaining material
 - **Why does SEE-N-READ™ work?**

SEE-N-READ™ works because:

 - It helps readers keep their eyes focused on the line they are reading (controls 'visual field')
 - Filters out distractions on the page (pictures, words on other lines, etc)
 - Reduces effort to keep track of where readers are on a page so that they focus more mental energy on what they are reading...improving reading comprehension

- **What we know about Left to Right Eye Movement and Reading:**
 - The act of reading left to right is not a natural process. If it were, people around the world would read left to right and we know other people in the world read right to left (Hebrew), up to down (Japanese) or both.
 - The left to right reading process is a learned act. Some readers learn the process easily and others need help to smoothly move left to right across a page of text
 - **SEE-N-READ™ supports control of eye movement for smooth reading left to right.**
- **How do you use the SEE-N-READ™?**
 - Lay it on the page and simply read the text in the clear window and move it down the page as you read.
- **How flexible is the SEE-N-READ™?**
 - SEE-N-READ™ can be used with any reading program directed at building fluency and comprehension or with any reading material and subject matter.
 - SEE-N-READ™ comes in two sizes: "Book" (5 ½" x 3" for smaller books) and "Document" (8 ½" x 3" for picture books and printed documents).
 - The clear reading window fits most font sizes (up to 20 font) commonly used by book publishers.
- **SEE-N-READ™ is Classroom Tested**

SEE-N-READ™ was tested for five years in various school settings ranging from Autism/Special Needs to Advanced Placement students. It is currently in use in 31 states.
- **SEE-N-READ™ is research-based**
 - SEE-N-READ'S™ practical design is based on extensive research in the fields of Reading, Dyslexia, Visual and Cognitive Processing.
